

Claude McNeal Productions Selected as One of Five Impact 100 Greater Indianapolis 2020 Change-Maker Finalists During Virtual "Big Reveal"

In its 15th year of grant making, charitable women's giving circle names five nonprofits who will vie virtually for a \$100,000 grant in July 2020

INDIANAPOLIS - Impact 100 Greater Indianapolis, a charitable women's giving circle, announced on June 16th during their "Big Reveal" virtual event that Claude McNeal Productions is one of five Change-Maker finalists. In addition to Nine 13 Sports, Friends of Indianapolis Dogs Outside (FIDO), Family Promise of Hendricks County and Paws & Think, Claude McNeal Productions will compete for a \$100,000 high-impact grant during the 15th Annual (1st virtual) Impact 100 Greater Indianapolis Awards Celebration on July 14, 2020. Impact 100 Greater Indianapolis will preserve one of the essential features of Impact 100 Greater Indianapolis by enabling current members to cast their votes electronically following seven-minute video presentations from each of the finalists. In order to broaden the impact of contributions from members and supporters to the \$206,000 grant pool, one nonprofit will be awarded the 2020 Impact 100 Change-Maker \$100,000 high-impact grant with the other four finalists receiving residual grants of \$26,500 each. Following the virtual celebration, the women of Impact 100 will have surpassed \$2.6 million in

- Impact 100 Greater Indianapolis is committed to helping Change-Maker finalists fund critical needs, new ventures, and innovative ways to solve social problems and to create a more civil and respectful climate in our community.
- Claude McNeal Productions' proposal is focusing on expanding the
 reach of our award-winning social-issue theatre program, ACT Out! A
 Change-Maker grant from IMPACT 100 would greatly impact our
 organization by helping to expand our youth prevention programming
 into 15 Indianapolis-area schools, serving 2,600 students. A sampling
 of topics covered by this program would include: "dealing with stress
 and anxiety in times of crisis", "the importance of social-distancing",
 "dealing with feelings of isolation and depression", "cyber-bullying",
 and (more important than ever before), "diversity and inclusion!"
- Impact 100 Greater Indianapolis Change-Maker finalists take part in a four-step grant application process led by volunteer members in which they go from dozens of applicants to five Change-Maker finalists which were announced during a "Big Reveal" on June 16.
